Training Area 5, Wetland/Waters of the U.S. Permitting, MS4 Permitting, VSMP Compliance, Fort Lee, Virginia

Kerr Environmental Services is serving as the environmental sub-consultant working with the Project Engineers and Department of Army - Fort Lee environmental staff in conjunction with the development of a *Joint Center for Consolidated Transportation Management Training (TA-5)* facility to accommodate *BRAC* recommendations. Development plans called for the design of a multi-use facility containing housing, recreational areas, headquarters, medical facilities, dining facilities, and ancillary support facilities arranged in a campus style setting on approximately 352-acres. Services included: assistance with minimization efforts to reduce impacts from stormwater management facilities, securing permits for wetland and stream encroachments, construction monitoring according to wetland permits, and monitoring stream water quality.

Kerr Environmental Services also prepared planting plans for habitat restoration within the 50-foot seaward Resource Protection Areas and managed plant material acquisition and installation.
