Kerr Environmental Services (KES) is preparing an Environmental Assessment for securing a Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) determination from the Army for the construction of a new 300 room resort building for a designated *Armed Forces Recreation Center* located at Fort Story.

The project is located within a designated Historic District, and is adjacent to First

Landing State Park. To obtain the FNSI, KES must coordinate with various military operations, State and Federal agencies and include public coordination regarding potential impacts to resources within and or adjacent to the project area. In addition, KES performed services for Coastal Zone Consistency and is managing a Phase I Environmental Assessment, Limited Hazardous Materials Survey and an archaeological investigation.
