

REGULATORY PERMITTING

Stoney Run Channel Improvements Department of Public Works, City of Newport News, Virginia

Kerr Environmental Services was retained to perform all environmental services related to the proposed widening of a 2,258 linear foot section of an unnamed tributary to Stoney Run to alleviate existing flooding problems within the Stoney Run watershed. Services included a wetland delineation and USACE confirmation, stream assessment, and several meetings with the USACE, the DEQ and the VMRC and prepared an



environmental permit application in collaboration with the City of Newport News and the civil engineer for the proposed project.
